DISASTER PLANNING BEFORE IT HAPPENS

TIPS/LESSONS LEARNED – BEFORE A DISASTER

- ▶ *TIP* - The essential operations of your community **MUST** be considered prior to a disaster. These could include;
 - Open communication platforms for vital community representatives
 - Restoration of utilities including additional utility representative contacts with the ability to establish outside agreements in a situation of need
 - Standby water pumps and where the water pumps will most likely be needed depending on structures and locations

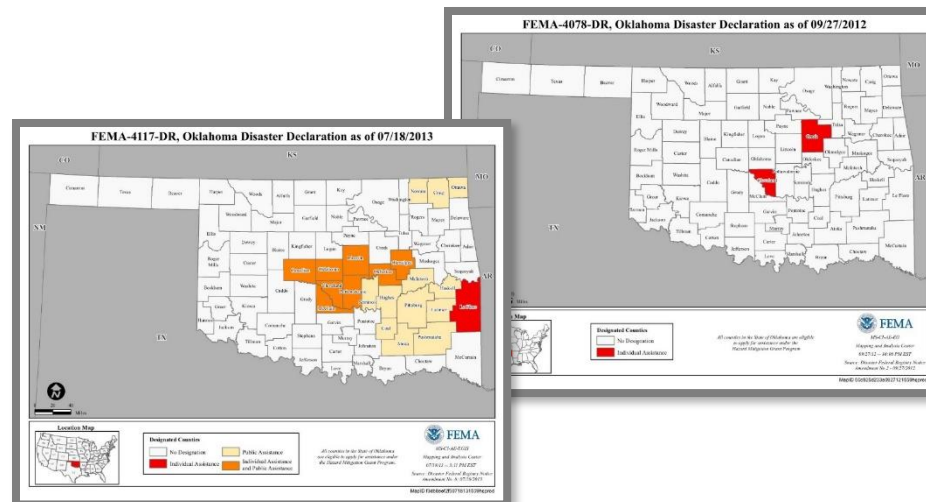
- ▶ *TIP* - Understand your localities ability to perform Program Administration for CDBG-DR funds.

 - > Ensuring all activities are **COMPLIANT AND REIMBURSABLE**
