Resolution on the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission and Water Control Infrastructure Drawdowns Before Flooding Events

Issue: A resolution urging the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to enact operating procedures consistent with their mission and design to reduce downstream flooding from imminent stormwater events.

Adopted Policy: The National Association of Counties (NACo) urges the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) to revise federal guidelines in coordination with local governing authorities that operate water control projects to reduce downstream stormwater events.
