

When residents receive services and supports, Riverside County focuses on addressing the presenting need or complaint, but often misses the chance to assess other needs, risks and resource opportunities.





Whole Person Health Score













The score measures a patient's health in six dimensions:

- Physical Health (considers factors like blood pressure and body mass index);
- Emotional Health (considers factors like mental health conditions and social support);
- **R**esource Utilization (considers factors like how often someone sees their doctor or takes medication);
 - Socioeconomics (considers factors like finances, housing and food access);
 - Ownership / Activation (considers factors like self-management and self-efficiency;
 - **N**utrition / Lifestyle (considers factors like diet, physical activity levels and substance use)
















Congregate Meals by Ethnicity
