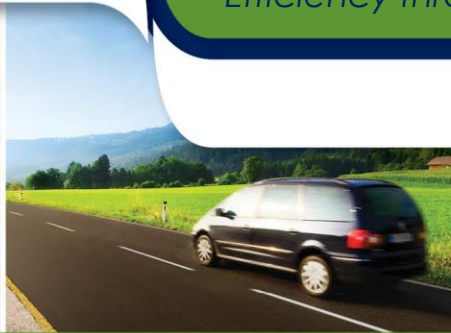

- Every Day Counts (EDC-3)



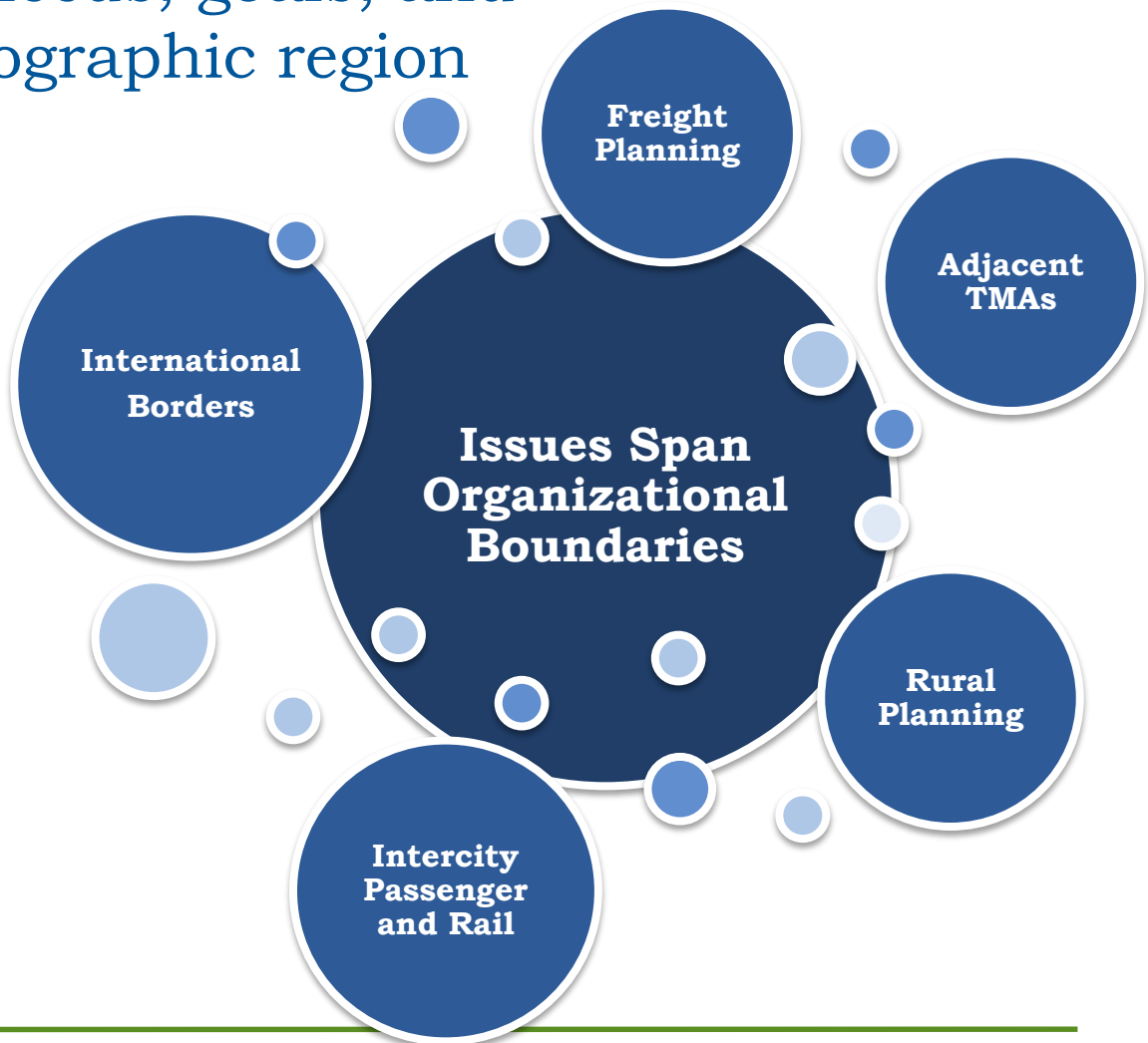

# Populations for Sample Megaregions

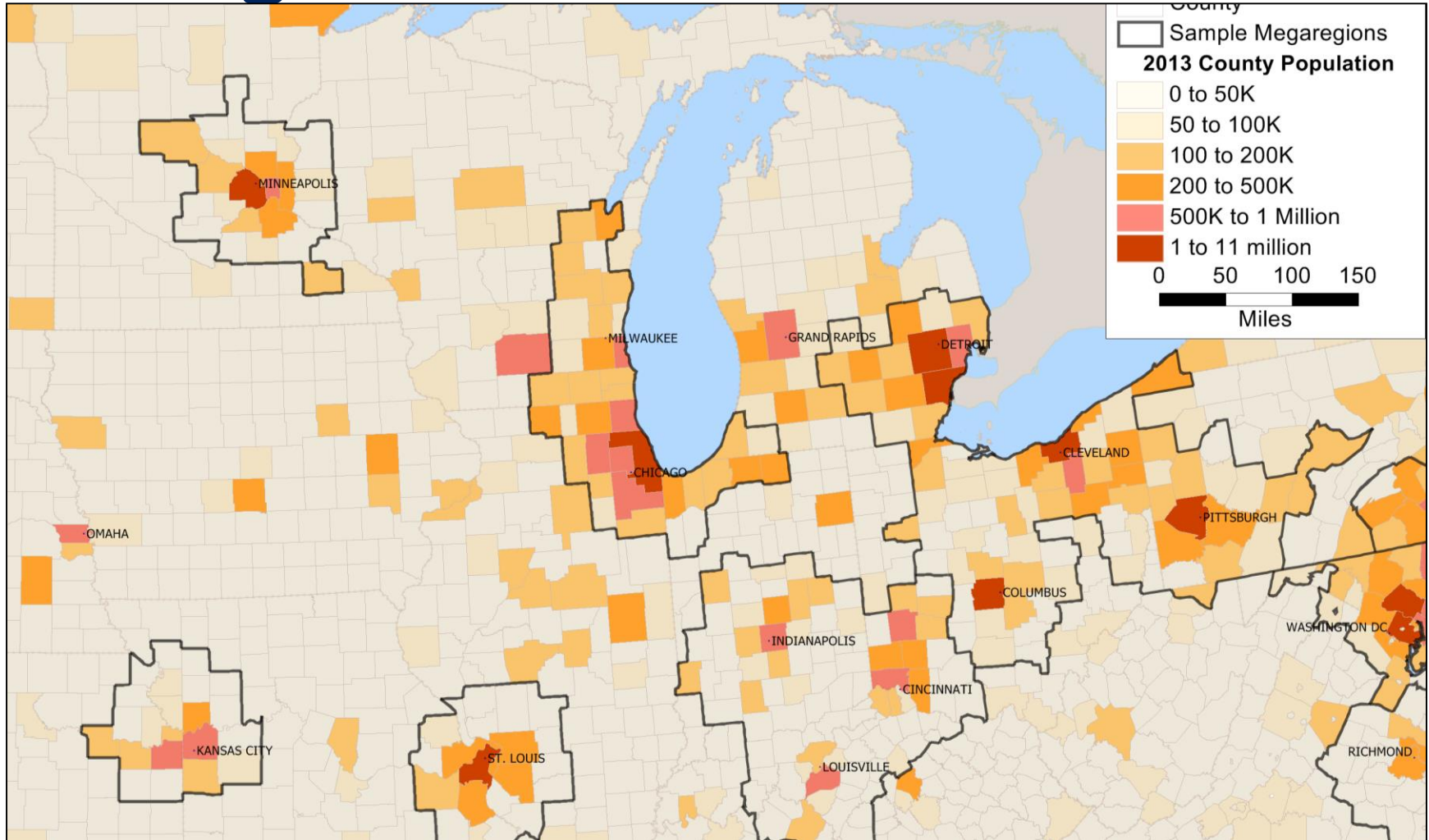


# Multijurisdictional Case Studies: Greater Philadelphia

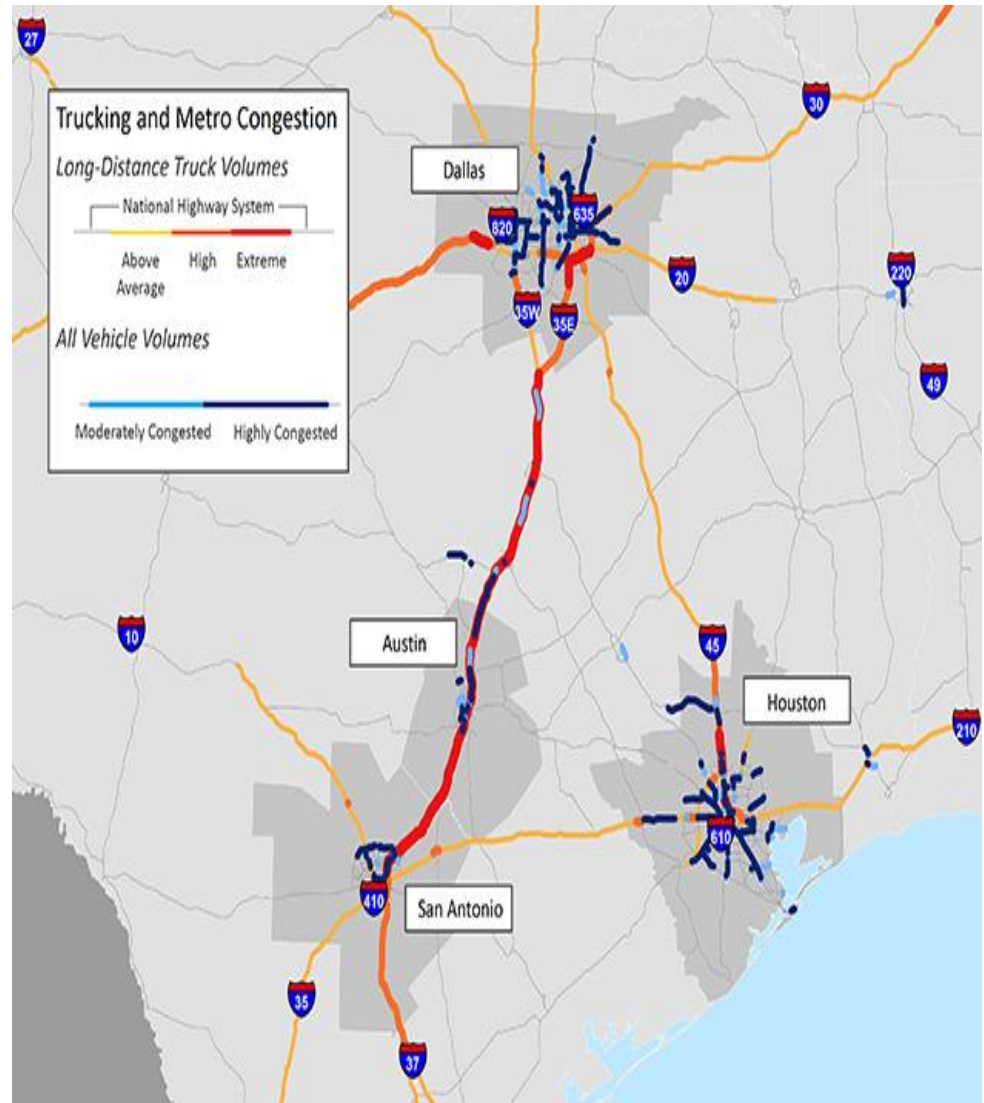

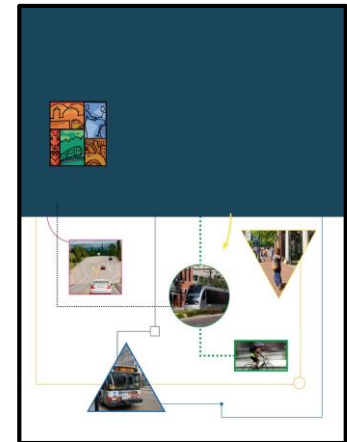
