



In partnership with the High-Performance Development Academy, NACo has been able to offer no-cost cyberattack quarterly simulations throughout 2021. The third quarter cyberattack simulation on third party partners was held Sept 27-Oct 1. With over 200 county participants, the daily exercises and checkin calls were very engaging; great information was shared, and many have already started to put into practice recommendations for managing third party partner risk. The fourth quarter scenario will be held November 27 – Nov 1 and will focus on insider threats. To learn more and register.
