Counties are blessed with immense talent, passion and commitment. Our promise is to harness and mobilize NACo's membership to pursue even stronger counties for a stronger America.


The 2017-18 Annual Report provides a snapshot of our collective accomplishments as a NACo team.






#### **NACo FSC DEBT OFFSET**




#### **CONNECTING THE UNCONNECTED**



- Financing







#### **FINANCIALS**

Total operating revenues were \$22.3 million, an increase of 17.5 percent over the prior year, after removing the impact of investment market gains. The most significant increases were from NACoFS Corp and grants. Total expenses were \$21.1 million, an increase of 1.9 percent from the prior year. The change in net assets from expenses was \$1.2 million. This added \$517,000 to unrestricted net assets and \$716,000 to temporarily restricted net assets.


