Develop a thorough and complete grant application addressing all NOFO requirements

- Pay particular attention to all merit and statutory criteria, ensuring all areaddressed in a way that results in a high rating as outlined in the NOFO
- Formulate a compelling project narrative using data that outlines why your project should be funded
- Utilize technical assistance opportunities and consultants wherever possible
