Grant Programs

Adult Co-occurring: The Reentry Program for Adult Offenders with Co-Occurring Substance Abuse and Mental Health Disorders aims to improve outcomes for adults with co-occurring substance abuse and mental health disorders through the screening and assessment of incarcerated individuals, availability of some pre-release programming, leading to the provision of appropriate evidence-based services and treatment after incarceration.

Adult Demonstration: The Adult Reentry Demonstration Program supports jurisdictions to develop and implement comprehensive and collaborative strategies that address the challenges posed by reentry to increase public safety and reduce recidivism for medium to high risk individuals reentering communities from incarceration.

Adult Mentoring: The Adult Mentoring and Transitional Services for Successful Reentry Program is a imed at promoting more effective and successful reentry for offenders through the establishment and maintenance of pre- and post-release mentoring relationships.

Adult Mentoring-Comprehensive: The Comprehensive Community-Based Adult Reentry Program Utilizing Mentors is aimed at promoting more effective and successful reentry for formerly incarcerated individuals through the utilization of comprehensive, evidence -based wrap-around reentry plans that address the identified needs of the individuals and are supported by trained mentors.

Family-Based Treatment: The Family-Based Adult Offender Substance Abuse Treatment Program establishes or enhances family-based residential substance abuse treatment programs in correctional facilities, including recovery and family supportive services.

Juvenile Co-occurring: The Reentry Program for Juveniles with Co-Occurring Substance Abuse and Mental Health Disorders funds improved drug treatment to juveniles in secure confinement and reduce long-term substance abusers' use of alcohol and other drugs while they are confined and through completion of court supervision.

Juvenile Demonstration: The Juvenile Reentry Program helps ensure that the transition the youth make from secure confinement facilities to the community is successful and promotes public safety. A secure confinement facility may include a juvenile detention center, juvenile correctional facility, or staff-secure facility.

Juvenile Mentoring: The Juvenile Mentoring Initiative provided funding to develop, implement, and expand mentoring programs and transitional services to reduce recidivism among juvenile ex-offenders, enhance safety in communities, and enhance the capacity of local partnerships to address the needs of juvenile ex-offenders returning to their communities.

Juvenile Systems Reform: The Comprehensive Statewide Juvenile Reentry Systems Reform program funds, at the state or local levels, policy and practice reforms to juvenile reentry systems and processes that reduce recidivism rates and improve positive outcomes for youth returning from confinement in state or locally run and/or managed juvenile correctional facilities.

Recidivism Reduction: The Comprehensive Statewide Adult Recidivism Reduction grant program provides resources to states to achieve a reduction in a historical baseline recidivism rate through planning and capacity-building with effective evidence-based interventions.

Reentry Court: The State, Local, and Tribal Reentry Courts program supported the development, establishment, and enhancement of state, local, and tribal reentry courts, court programs, and specialized reentry court dockets that combine monitoring activities with comprehensive and coordinated services for formerly incarcerated individuals returning to their homes and communities.

Smart Probation: The Smart Probation program sought to improve probation success rates, which would in turn improve public safety, reduce admissions to prisons and jails, and save taxpayer dollars. Funds could be used to implement evidence -based supervision strategies and to innovate new strategies to improve outcomes for probationers.

Smart Supervision: The Smart Probation program was broadened and renamed in FY 2014 to include initiatives for individuals on parole supervision.

Solicited: Supplemental funds can be awarded to previous grantees for the purposes of an evaluation or other activity.

Technology Career Training: The goal of the Technology Career Training Program for Incarcerated Adults and Juveniles grant program is to increase the post-release employability of the incarcerated population in related technology-based jobs and career fields. The objective of the program is to establish and provide technology career training programs for incarcerated adults and juveniles during the 6-18 month period before release from a prison, jail, or juvenile facility.

Young Fathers Mentoring: The Strengthening Relationships Between Young Fathers and Their Children: A Reentry Mentoring Project grant program helps ensure that the transition young fathers make from secure confinement facilities and out-of-home placement back to their families and their communities is successful and promotes public safety. This program funds mentoring and comprehensive transitional services that emphasize development of parenting skills in offenders who are young fathers.
