

Innovation is far more than good ideas!







Innovation is a new idea, device or process.[1]
Innovation can be viewed as the application of better solutions that meet new requirements, inarticulated needs, or existing market needs



Key Points regarding innovation:

- ▶ It is about re-thinking business processes.
- It generally involves more than one individual.
- Often requires a climate or environment that encourages a desire to perform things better.
- Is often citizen-centric.
- Is not always about technology.
- Caution!: Staff often view "innovation" with job cuts.

- 8. Leadership & Vision







