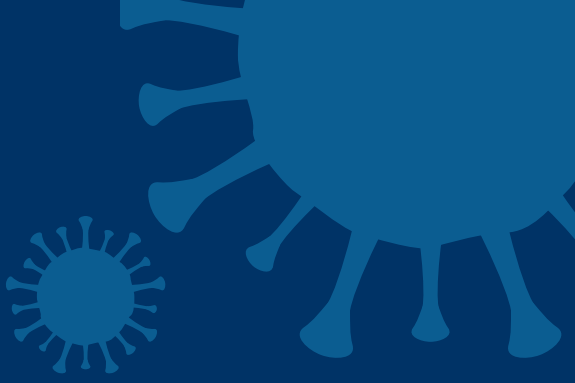


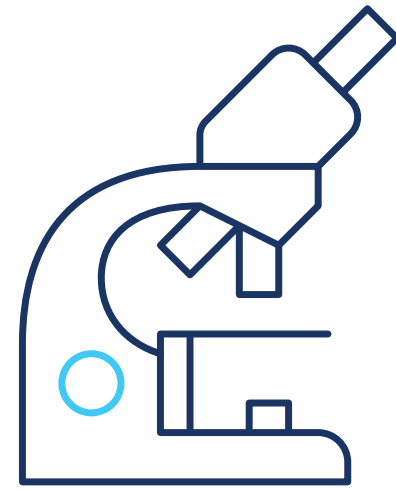

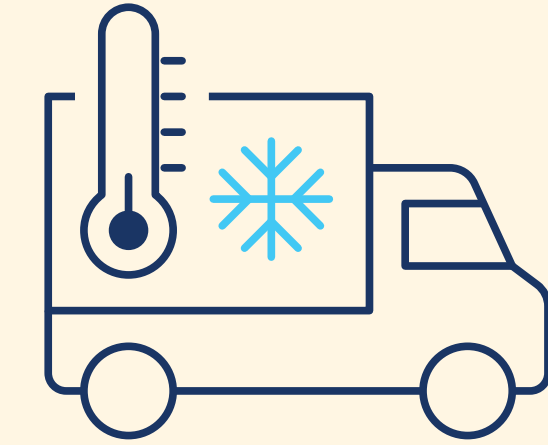
Families First Coronavirus Response Act (P.L. 116-127)

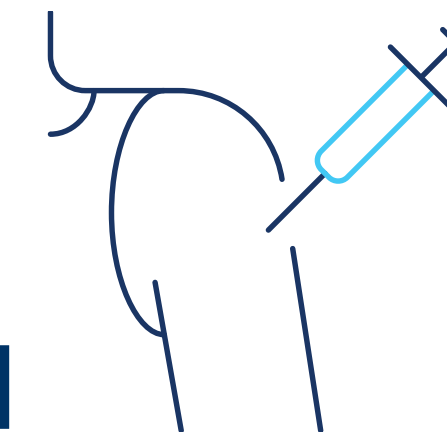

American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (P.L.117-2)

\$7.5 BILLION

For direct grants from CDC to state, local, tribal and public health departments and community health centers to distribute vaccines.



\$7.5 BILLION

To the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to establish vaccination sites across the country.



\$7.6 BILLION

For state, local and territorial public health departments to expand and sustain the public health workforce.
