Strengthen leadership capacity and provide support to on-going, successful efforts within coal communities



Action Challenge Cohorts

A technical assistance and capacity-building program

Participants

Up to 15 under-resourced, coal communities; teambased applicants

Activities

- In-depth, individual coaching
- Receive support for 12 months
- Create economic diversification and community revitalization plan
- In-person capstone event

Goal

Create and advance fundable economic revitalization and diversification projects



Storytelling

A national campaign to capture educational and inspirational stories of coal communities

- Highlight community success stories
- Profile community leaders
- Share challenges and approaches
- Create web portal and landing page for resources
