### **PROVISION:**



HHS Secretary to negotiate prices for certain Medicare drugs







Pharmacies, Providers



Drug manufacturers to pay rebates if Medicare drug prices faster than inflation.

Caps out-of-pocket drug spending for beneficiaries in Medicare Part D at \$2,000 annually







Extends Affordable Care Act (ACA) Subsides for 3 years



### **WHO IT IMPACTS:**



Low- income individuals buying health insurance on the healthcare marketplace



County health facilities that see large numbers of indigent and uninsured residents

### **OVERVIEW OF IMPACT**

 Prevents steep increases in Marketplace premium payments

Minimizes the impact of potential premium increases

 Minimizes the impact of healthcare coverage loss at the end of the PHE Important for counties, these subsidies allow low-income individuals to obtain affordable health insurance based on their income, reducing the number of uninsured and medically indigent individuals seeking care in county health facilities.

- \$5 billion Climate Pollution Reduction Program to provide grants to state and local governments for greenhouse gas air pollution reduction planning and implementation activities

# ELECTRIFICATION OF COMMERCIAL & RESIDENTIAL BUIDLINGS



### **BUILDING ENERGY CODE ADOPTION | \$1 BILLION**

 Provides \$1 billion to DOE to award grants to states and local governments to adopt building energy or zero-energy codes for residential and commercial buildings

### HIGH-EFFECIENCY ELECTRIC HOME REBATE PROGRAM | \$4.3 BILLION

- Provides \$4.3 billion to DOE to award grants to state energy offices to administer high-efficiency electric home rebate programs for low- or moderate-income households
- Counties can receive rebates to carry out electrification on a household's behalf



### **ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE**

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM | \$3 BILLION**

*Eligible activities include:* 

- Community-led air and other pollution air monitoring, prevention and remediation and investments in low- and zero-emission and resilient technologies and related infrastructure and workforce development that help reduce greenhouse gas emissions and other air pollutants
- Mitigating climate and health risks from urban heat islands, extreme heat, wood heater emission and wildfire events
- Climate resiliency and adaptation
- Reducing indoor toxins and air pollution
- Facilitating engagement of disadvantaged communities in state and federal advisory groups, workshops, rulemakings and other public processes

Counties that partner with a local nonprofit are eligible to receive funding under the program

## ONSHORE WIND AND SOLAR RIGHTS OF WAY

### 2017-2022 OUTER CONTINENTAL SHELF LEASING PROGRAM

To issue an offshore wind energy lease, DOI must hold an offshore oil and gas lease sale of at least 60 million acres the year prior

To issue a right-of-way for wind and solar development, DOI must hold an onshore oil and gas lease sale in the four months prior

IRA reinstates an oil and gas lease sale in the Gulf of Mexico and requires

DOI to conduct three additional lease sales







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
