


# What Help Me Grow does...

# Powerful grid = right resources at the right times









Provide support to pregnancy and pediatric providers to screen their patients and connect them to resources for:


- Child Development

# Call Volume in 2020




# **Most Impacted Zip Codes**


Average Monthly Percentage of Calls from June and July 2020

Developing a *positive network* is a key step in the healing process.
















