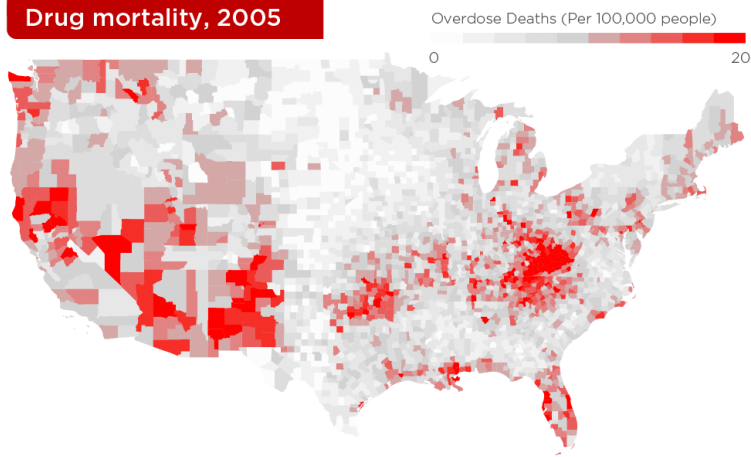


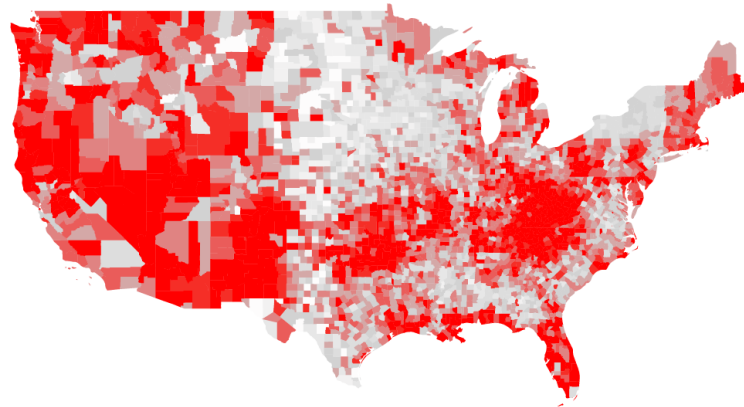
America's Opioid Crisis

The stunning spread of the opioid painkiller and heroin epidemic in two maps over 10 years.

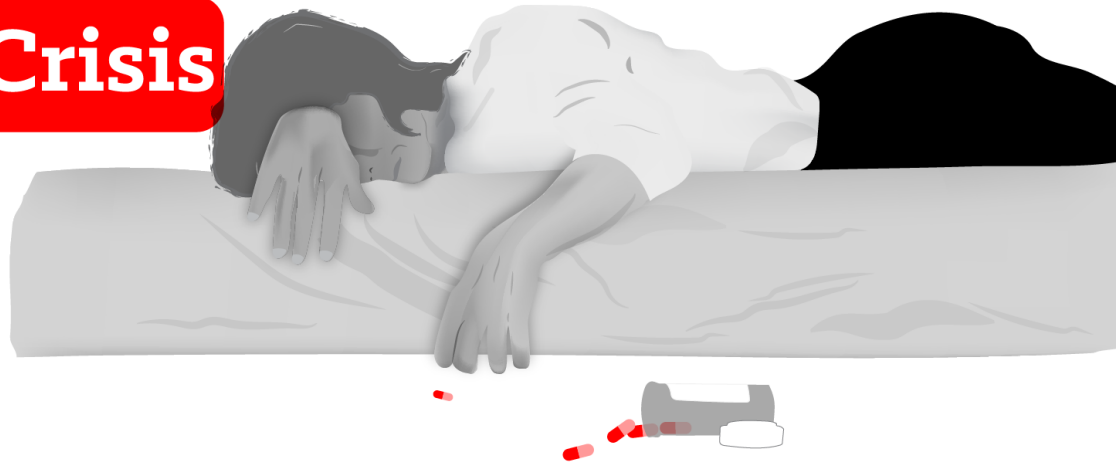
Drug mortality, 2005



Drug mortality, 2014



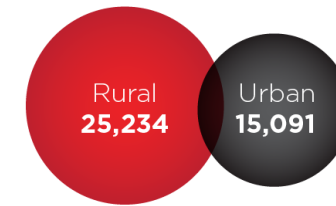

A challenge for cities, counties and states

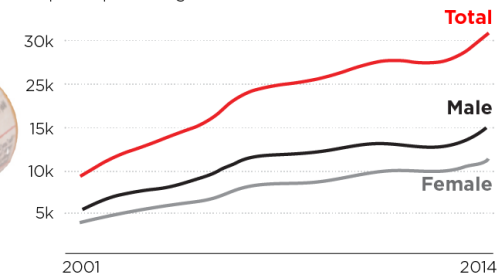
The rise in prescription opioid and heroin addiction is causing an increase in overdoses as well as more cases of HIV/AIDs and hepatitis C.

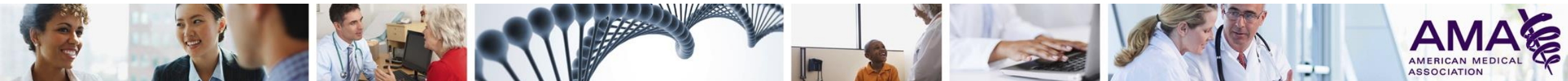
With more than 78 people dying every day from opioids, what can one physician do?



AMA Task Force to Reduce Opioid Abuse

- Increase physicians' registration and use of PDMPs
- Ensure safe, evidence-based prescribing
- Support comprehensive pain care; reduce the stigma of pain
- Reduce the stigma of substance use disorder; increase access to treatment
- Increase access to naloxone to save lives from overdose; support broad Good Samaritan protections

Prevention

- New opioid prescription guidelines for local providers and UB Medical School
- 5-day limit on opioid prescriptions without prior-authorization through major insurers
- Early planning to develop a Center of Excellence in Pain Management

Education

- Informational forums in every community
- Developing a YouTube video series
- Working group with school superintendents to roll out joint curriculum
- Aggressive press including strategic announcement of overdose fatalities
